## Permit Request Procedure

- Submit your request form and the \$175 fee to the AHA Transportation office by August 4th.
- Permits are issued by lottery—senior names are drawn first; junior names are drawn second.
- Requests submitted after August 4th are placed in a pool for remaining permits and issued on a first-come, first served basis. If any permits remain after completion of this procedure, students can purchase them throughout the school year.
- Permits are available on the first day of school.

## AHA Student Parking Regulations

- 1. Students must park in their assigned parking spot only--enforced from 5 a.m. to 2:40 pm.
- 2. Students are to drive cautiously and observe the campus speed limit—10 miles per hour at all times. Failure to do so results in a \$25 fine and possible loss of parking privileges.
- 3. Students must stop at all stop signs and observe one-way lanes on campus. Students must leave their vehicles and the parking lot immediately upon arrival and may not return until dismissal from school.
- 4. Students are not to obstruct other cars entering or leaving the parking lot.
- 5. Students must have their parking permits displayed from the rear-view mirror with the number clearly visible in the front windshield. Permits must be visible at all times the vehicle is on school grounds during the school day.
- 6. Students driving more than one vehicle must register each vehicle with the school.
- 7. Parking fines are \$25 for each offense.
- 8. Students should see the transportation office immediately if the permit is lost or stolen or if someone is in their assigned parking spot.
- 9. Fee for replacement of lost permits is \$5.
- 10. Students parking in the AHA parking lot must enter and exit using the stoplight at the intersection of 67<sup>th</sup> Street and Nicollet Avenue. Students parking in the St. Peter's lot must enter and exit from Wentworth Avenue.
